

## Answers to your Loft Questions:

- ★ The displayed loft represents what one student bed can be converted into with the rental of a loft from BedLoft. Therefore, both roommates may desire to rent a loft to maximize floor space; however both students do not need to rent a loft.
- ★ The futon can be purchased separately; with or without a loft rental.
- ★ The loft will require the use of the metal bed frame and mattress provided in the residence hall room. The headboard and footboard provided in the residence hall room will not be needed and are **THE ONLY PIECES** of residence hall furniture that may be removed from the hall to be stored off campus. The headboard and footboard will need to be returned in original condition when the student checks out of the residence hall room.
- ★ On move in day, you will be able to pick up your pre-ordered loft. Student volunteers from National Residence Hall Honorary and the Housing Welcome Crew will be available to assist you with the pick up process. Due to an increase in student population and the popularity of this program it is strongly advised that you pre-order a loft. - ★ Students in McGregor Hall and Southwest Hall can opt to rent a high loft conversion kit. The rental price is \$95 for the academic year and billed to your student account. BedLoft rented lofts or homemade lofts are prohibited in these two halls.
